# **Spring Grants Cycle**

We're Excited to Announce This Year's Grant Recipients!

Thanks to the success of last year's Northern Neck Beach Music Festival, the Colonial Beach Community Foundation proudly awarded \$20,000 in grants to support projects that strengthen and uplift our town.



Here's how those funds are making a difference:

- Colonial Beach Volunteer Fire Department
  - \$5,000 for specialized equipment for extraction and embankment rescues
  - \$2,000 for fire prevention education in schools and the wider community
- Colonial Beach Historical Society & Museum
  - \$1,000 to enhance the garden area with outdoor seating, lighting, and other improvements
- CB Creative
  - \$1,000 for permanent signage
- CB Greenspace
  - \$1,200 for durable, waterproof educational signage
- CB Community Center
